Year 8 into 9 Options Information Evening

I write to invite you to our Year 8 into 9 Options Information Event, which will take place in school on **Tuesday 11 February 2025**. We are running two sessions: **4pm – 5.30pm** or **5.30pm – 7pm**. To enable us to manage attendance at the event, please book your slot for your preferred session using via this <u>form</u>. You only need to book one ticket for your whole family.

As our young people move into Year 9, they have the opportunity to start to make some decisions about the subjects they wish to study. In Year 9 all of our students study a broad base of subjects that will give them a secure grounding. They supplement this with two options subjects.
